Week 1

2. Do you think Daniel had any doubts as he faced possible death?
3. Is there a doubt that you're struggling with right now?

1. Have you ever experienced peer pressure?
2. The three men in Daniel chapter 3 refused to bow down and worship an idol, what do you think that says about who they are?
3. Would it bother you if God didn't save them when they were thrown into the furnace?

Week 4

Daniel 5:1-30

1. Do you ever feel insecure?
2. What does it mean to honor God?
3. How do you feel like we honor God as a family?

Week 5

Daniel 6:1-28

1. Do you think it's hard to live as a Christian?
2. Do you feel like you've been tested like Daniel was?
3. What did you learn about Daniel in this series?
4. Are you looking forward to the Mission series that is coming next?
