- What is it?
 - This event is celebrating your elementary child elevating into Jr. High.
- When is it?
 - June 9th, 2023.
- Where is it?
 - Scandia Family Fun Center in Victorville 12627 Mariposa Road, Victorville, CA 92392.
- Who can come?
 - Only current 6th graders.
- Where do I sign up?
 - Guest central online.
- How much does it cost?
 - \$10
- How many spots are there?
 - Limited to 100 spots for this event.
- How long do I have to register my student?
 - All students must be registered by Monday, May 30th.
- What does it include?
 - Pizza & drinks.
 - Scandia Diamond Pass
 - This Pass includes unlimited rides on the Tilt Tower, Stockholm Raceway, Michael Jackson's Slide, the Bumper Boats, our new Thor's Chariot, also the new Denmark Drop Tower, and a one time ride on the Sky Screamer. This will also give you access to both of our beautifully landscaped golf courses with unlimited golf. In addition to the rides, you will receive a 25-point game card, your point card can be used for arcades and/or batting cages.
- What do they need to bring?
